INFORMATION NEEDED ON INVOICES

Investigation of Arbitration complaints and routine seed tonnage auditing have revealed the need for more complete information on invoices.

Farmers who purchase seed and later need to file for seed arbitration are required to give the lot number of the seed purchased. This information was lacking on many of the cases filed, and often became a "guess", making the cases very difficult to arbitrate.

Also, Plant Board Auditors have been routinely auditing licensed seed dealers and their subsidiaries, and one of the most common errors found is a lack of information on the invoice.

The very least amount of information on invoices required both by federal and state laws is the **lot number and kind and/or variety** of seed. The lot number should tie this invoice to other information required to be kept for each lot, such as the analysis used to back up the information required on the label. Other needed information for the auditors is **whether the seed was sold as certified seed or not, the address (city/state) of the buyer, bulk or bagged, and weight of the bag**. When all this information is routinely provided on the invoices, the auditor can complete the audit with little disruption of the company's daily business. The time needed to complete an audit greatly depends on the information available on the invoices.

Therefore: **Please check your procedures and make sure the following information is on your invoices:**

- **Lot Number**
- **Kind and Variety**
- **Certified or not**
- **Bulk or Bagged and Bag Weight**
- **Address of Buyer (city/state)**

Advertising Certified Rice or Soybean Seed

If you are a certified grower in the Arkansas Certification Program, you may advertise that you have certified seed for sale. If you advertise early in the season, be sure to follow through on all the requirements. Staff will check to see if samples have been submitted for complete analysis and certified grades and/or tags issued. If you advertise during the planting season, and have not yet submitted samples for complete analysis, you will be subject to the appropriate **enforcement** action.

Sample Ads (early in season):

- 1) Taking orders for Certified Hutcheson Seed. Name, Phone #

- 2) Certified Growers/Dealers - Drew Rice available for bulk transfer. Name, Phone #

Before placing an early season ad, it would be wise to at least have a sample submitted for germ, varietal purity and noxious weeds. Follow up as soon as possible with cleaned seed samples for complete analysis.

Do not advertise soybeans or rice as Bulk Certified, Field Certified, or Subject to Certification if bagged & tagged.

- 1) **Bulk Certified - Not available for Rice or Soybeans!** Regulations require the seed to be bagged in regular size bags or approved reusable containers with certified tags. (See regulations in Circular 15, General Seed Certification Standards, section L).

- 2) **Field Certification - There is no such designation!** Checking the field to see if it meets certification requirements is only a first step in the process of certification. After it passes the field inspection, a sample must be drawn by our inspector on the cleaned seed to check the purity, germination and moisture (complete analysis) to see if it meets the standards for certification. If it does, an analysis report will be issued showing the seed made certified blue-tag grade. After the seed is bagged in the proper containers, certified tags can be issued.

- 3) **Subject to certification if bagged & tagged - should only be used on invoices** for seed varieties allowed to be sold as non certified. A complete analysis showing the lot was tested and eligible for a certified grade is required to be on file.

Remember,

A certification permit only allows the sale of bagged and tagged certified seed. The only other option available for selling rice or soybeans under the seed certification permit is to sell it to another certified grower/dealer on a bulk transfer form. This transfers the certification responsibilities to another certified grower to complete the certification process. If you find another certified grower who wants to buy the seed on a bulk transfer form, please note that one copy of the form goes with the sale, which the buyer must sign and return a copy to our office, and one copy to the Plant Board's Seed Division.

If you are selling non-certified seed, you need a Seed Dealers License, complete analyses and payment of tonnage fees.

USE OF BULK TRANSFERS IN CERTIFICATION

PURPOSE:

Bulk Transfer forms are used in the certification process to transfer ownership of seed in the certification program from one certified grower / dealer to another. The original intent was for unconditioned seed to be transferred, although this process can be used on cleaned seed. The certified grower / dealer who receives the seed is responsible for completing the certification process on the seed. This includes having an inspector send in a sample for complete analysis.

FORMS:

Form 24 (Intrastate -within AR-) Bulk Seed Transfer

Form 24 A (Interstate -between states-) Bulk Seed Transfer

PROCESS:

Seller -

1. The Bulk Transfer document (Form 24) must accompany the shipment of seed.
2. The seller completes the top portion of the form. This lists the name & address of the original producer, the seller (if different) and the buyer, as well as a description of the kind, variety, grade applied for, lot #, number of bushels in the shipment and date.
3. The seller makes a copy of the document and immediately faxes or sends to the Plant Board. **(This documentation is for the protection of the seller and shows no tonnage fees are due from the seller of this seed.)**

NOTE: Buyer must complete Certification for Seller to maintain Priority Status for Foundation Seed.

Buyer -

1. The buyer completes the lower portion of the form that came with the shipment. This lists the date the shipment is received, the number of bushels, the transfer of authority for issuance of certification labels, and the buyer's signature/date.
2. The buyer immediately sends the completed form to the Plant Board.
3. The buyer is responsible for completion of certification which includes a complete analysis and bagging/labeling in compliance with certification regulations. The original producer's certification number (C-number) must be used on the label.
4. **If the buyer decides not to complete the certification process and sells the seed as non-certified (if eligible), then he is responsible for complying with regulations regarding an AR Seed Dealer's license and payment of tonnage fees, as well as all labeling requirements.**

BULK TRANSFER OF SEED PENDING CERTIFICATION

Use this document to transfer seed certification responsibilities from one **Arkansas Certified Seed Grower** to another. SEED APPLICANT or SELLER, complete sections 1, 2, 3, and 4. BUYER, complete section 5.

This document must accompany the shipment of seed.

INFORMATION on the SALE of PLANTING SEED in ARKANSAS

Any person who sells, offers for sale, or distributes agricultural* seed for planting purposes within or into the state shall have in force a valid Seed Labeler's License, pay the required tonnage fees, and label the seed in accordance with Circular 10: Regulations on the Sale of Planting Seed in Arkansas. There are some exceptions for the license requirements.**

A COMPLETE ANALYSIS (germ & purity) is required to supply the labeling information on all agricultural seed sold for planting purposes, bulk or bagged. The information required on the label is listed below: (The labeling information on bulk sales must accompany each sale, either on the invoice or on a separate sheet or tag.)

- 1) The seedman's name and address.
- 2) The kind and variety, or if variety is not listed, the words "**Variety Not Stated.**" Exception: In seed of **wheat, soybeans, rice and cotton**, the label must contain the variety name. **Note: See Circular 10, Section 2. D for requirements on labeling variety and brands.**)
- 3) The Lot Number.
- 4) The state where the seed was grown; if unknown, a statement to that effect.
- 5) The year grown for certified cotton.
- 6) The percentage of pure seed.
- 7) The percentage of weed seed, including noxious weeds.
- 8) The percentage of other crop.
- 9) The percentage of inert matter.
- 10) The percentage of germination, exclusive of hard seed, and percentage of hard seed, if present.
- 11) The date the germination test was completed, given by month and year. The test is valid for nine months, not including the month the seed was tested.
- 12) Net weight of contents, with the exception of corn, which may be on the label or bag in the vicinity of the label.
- 13) Any tall fescue must show on the tag that the seed contains ryegrass, if any, and the amount given in percentage. If no ryegrass is found in the sample, the tag shall state, "No Ryegrass Found".
- 14) Name and number of noxious weed seeds present per pound, or if none are present, a statement to that effect.

If the seed is treated, there are additional requirements for labeling, either on the analysis tag, a separate treatment tag, or on a side or top of the container. The label must show the name of the substance used for treatment, the appropriate toxicity category signal word and a precautionary statement such as: "Do not use for food, feed or oil purposes".

* ***Agricultural seed includes*** the seeds of grass, forage, cereal, and fiber crops and any other kinds of seeds commonly recognized within the state as agricultural seed and mixtures of such seeds. Garden and lima beans, spinach, mustard, turnip, and garden pea seed is included as agricultural seed when in containers of 25 pounds or more.

****You DO NOT need the \$250 annual seed labeler's license if:**

1. You **grow 100 acres or less of certified seed and only** sell your own production of bagged and tagged Arkansas Certified seed. (You will need a \$100 certification permit, and follow regulations in Circ. 15: Official Standards for Seed Certification in Arkansas.)
2. You **only** sell seed that has been sampled, tested, and for which labels have been completely printed by the State Plant Board. In order for the Plant Board to print labels, our inspector must draw the sample from cleaned, bagged seed, and you must label the seed by variety name. Form DV-88: Declaration of Variety for Non-Certified Seed, must be on file at the Plant Board. (If you just want information on the seed's value for planting, you may sample the seed in bulk or bag and send it in for testing, but it will not be eligible for Plant Board printed tags.)
3. You **only** sell seed obtained from a licensed seedsman who is in full compliance with these regulations (Circ. 10), which includes paying the tonnage fees on the seed.

INFORMATION FOR PRODUCING/ADVERTISING/SELLING CERTIFIED SEED

We have two circulars regarding regulations on seed: 1) Circular 10 - Regulations on the Sale of Planting Seed in Arkansas, and 2) Circular 15 - Official Standards for Seed Certification in Arkansas. The following list will point out some of the important things to remember from these regulations.

- 1) **Seed can be called "Certified" only** - if it is bagged and tagged with an official certification label. (EXCEPTION: Certified Blue-tag grade Wheat may be sold in bulk.) This means going through the entire process of certification - application, field inspection, an inspector's sample on clean seed for purity and germination that makes the grade applied for, and labels printed and attached to the bagged seed. (NOTE: Our regulations allow certified blue-tag wheat to be sold in the bulk; it still requires this entire process, except bagging, and the labeling information is given on a bulk certificate instead of a tag/label. For more information on selling bulk certified wheat, call the Plant Board Seed Division or your area inspector.)
- 2) **The only bulk sales of Arkansas certified seed currently allowed** - are bulk transfers between two licensed certified seedsmen, and blue-tag grade certified wheat. Seed applied on for certification may be sold from one licensed certified seedsman to another, in bulk, provided the identity of the seed has been maintained at all times and the appropriate **bulk transfer form accompanies the shipment**. After the seed is moved it must be sampled for a complete analysis (purity and germ), bagged and tagged, to be sold as certified. If it is sold as non-certified, the seedsman who purchased the seed on the bulk transfer is responsible for labeling & paying tonnage fees on these seed sales.
- 3) **Uncleaned seed may be sampled by an inspector** - for germ, varietal purity, noxious weeds and moisture as an aid in making conditioning decisions. However, **a complete analysis (germ and purity) must be performed on cleaned seed before a certified grade can be issued**. These samples on cleaned seed may be drawn by our inspector on bulk seed when blue-tag certified is needed. Registered and Foundation grades are only issued on samples drawn from cleaned, bagged seed.
- 4) **"Eligible for certification if bagged and tagged"** - was originally intended only for invoices, to allow auditors to identify seed that was bulk transferred, and still in the process of obtaining certification. This statement may only be used on invoices of sales of seed applied on and approved in the field and the lab, yet lacking the final process of certification (bagging and tagging). **This seed is not certified and should not be advertised as such. This statement cannot be applied to uncleaned seed. Without an analysis on cleaned seed, eligibility for certification is unknown.**
- 5) **A complete analysis (germ and purity) is required to supply the labeling information on all seed sold, both certified and non-certified**. The information required on the label is listed in Circular 10, Section 2.C. The labeling information on bulk sales must accompany each sale, either on the invoice or on a separate sheet or tag.
- 6) **If you grow 100 acres or less of certified seed, A \$100 Certification Permit** - is all that is required for selling your own production of bagged/tagged certified seed or bulk transfers. A Seed Dealers's License(\$250) is required for any other sales of seed not labeled by the Plant Board (Cir. 10, Section 2. Licensing-Reporting-Labeling). A Certification Permit may be upgraded to a license for an additional \$150.

ARKANSAS SEED COUNCIL POLICY FOR ALLOCATION OF FOUNDATION SEED

1. If seed supply is greater than or equal to the amount of seed requested then all requests from priority 1, 2, and 3 growers (see below) will be filled.
2. If seed supply is greater than or equal to the amount of seed requested from priority 1 and 2 growers then all requests from priority 1 and 2 growers will be filled. Requests from priority 3 growers will be filled by setting a base allocation and a cap (maximum amount one grower can receive). Requests less than or equal to the base allocation would receive 100% of request. Requests greater than the base allocation would receive the base allocation plus a percentage allocation of the request above the base allocation.
3. If seed supply is greater than or equal to the amount of seed requested from priority 1 growers then all requests from priority 1 growers will be filled. Requests from priority 2 growers will be filled by setting a base allocation and a cap (maximum amount one grower can receive). Requests less than or equal to the base allocation would receive 100% of request. Requests greater than the base allocation would receive the base allocation plus a percentage allocation of the request above the base allocation.
4. If seed supply is less than the amount of seed requested from priority 1 growers then requests from priority 1 growers will be filled by setting a base allocation and a cap (maximum amount one grower can receive). Requests less than or equal to the base allocation would receive 100% of request. Requests greater than the base allocation would receive the base allocation plus a percentage allocation of the request above the base allocation.
5. For varieties on which no advance deposit is required for the first year and an advance deposit is required for the second year, a grower's request for the first year will be set at the lowest request for the two years.
6. These guidelines may be modified by specific action(s) of the Arkansas Seed Council.

ARKANSAS SEED COUNCIL GROWER PRIORITIES

<u>PRIORITY</u>	<u>QUALIFICATIONS</u>
1.	Growers who have produced officially registered (purple tag) seed of the crop requested at least one of the previous two (2) years. (Immediate past crop does not count since certification is not complete.) In the event that a grower has purchased Foundation seed of a variety of the same crop for which the registered class of seed is not recognized, the grower's status will be considered Priority One if the grower has produced officially certified (blue tag) seed of the crop requested at least one of the previous two years (Immediate past crop does not count since certification is not complete.)
2.	Growers who have produced officially certified (blue tag) seed of the crop requested for the previous three (3) consecutive years. (Immediate past crop does not count since certification is not complete.)
3.	Growers who are top producers and have officially certified seed of other crops within the past five (5) years. (Immediate past crop does not count since certification is not complete.)

Subject: Maintaining Priority Status for Receiving
Arkansas Foundation Seed

There has been some confusion over the last couple years about Certified Growers not maintaining their “Priority One” status for receiving Foundation Seed from the University of Arkansas.

To be a Priority One Grower you MUST do the following:

- Plant Foundation Seed;
- Fields Must pass field inspection for Registered Grade;
- Clean & Bag Seed;
- Sampled by State Plant Board Inspector (can be sampled in bulk if planting back for own Blue Tag Production; must file application for BT Production);
- Pass lab standards for Registered Grade;
- Print Registered Labels or plant back for own seed production (can be sampled in bulk if planting back for own Blue Tag Production; must file application for BT Production).

Most of the problems occur when the Certification Process is not completed by either the entity that applied for Certification, the person who has control of the entity that applied for Certification, or the company that receives the certification responsibility of a Bulk Transfer.

EXAMPLES OF PROBLEMS:

- A. Use of the Form 24's-Bulk Seed Transfer of Certification Responsibilities: A problem occurs after a Certified Grower sells the seed using Form 24, if the Company that bought the seed does not sample the seed in the bag as Registered Grade and then purchase registered labels; or, if the buyer does not keep the seed separate and mixes it with the buyer's own seed of the same variety/class or another certified grower seed which causes the identity of the seed to be lost.
- B. A second problem occurs when a Certified Grower has 2 or more entities and combines the seed from all entities, or when certified grower *bulk transfers* the seed under the wrong name. Each entity must stand on its own as far as bagging and tagging of the seed or replanting the seed for their own production. (Example: Jimmie Shatsar, Shatsar Farms, & Jimmie Shatsar/Linda Hutson-Shatsar will be considered 3 entities if an Application for Certification is received under each name. Each entity must complete certification under each name as listed on the Certification Application.)
- C. Another problem is when a Certified Grower submits an application for Registered Class, his field passes field inspection, the seed is tested in the bag or bulk, **but** he does not order labels or use the seed for his Certified Blue Tag Production the following season.

These are a few reasons which prevent a Certified Grower from keeping Priority One Status. The main thing to remember is, complete the certification process for your Registered seed production, especially if you sell the seed on Form 24. When transferring the seed, please be aware that the company that is buying the seed may not complete Certification on the seed. One way to avoid this is to always bag & tag a portion of the seed yourself.

INFORMATION ON PLANT BOARD LABORATORY ANALYSES

The Plant Board Seed Laboratory is the Official Seed Laboratory for Arkansas. All tests are conducted according to the rules and regulations established by the Association of Official Seed Analysts (AOSA). The Seed Division currently has seven employees who have completed training and testing required to be AOSA Certified Seed Analysts in either purity, germination or both. There are three types of samples received by the Seed Lab: Certified, Non-Certified, and Regulatory.

CERTIFIED SEED SAMPLES:

Certified Seed is seed that has been produced in accordance with the high standards and regulations outlined in Circular 15: Official Standards for Seed Certification in Arkansas. The Seed Lab checks these samples for Kind, variety, weed seed, other crop, inert and noxious weeds. Besides the physical purity, where the seed is checked for characteristics of the variety such as size, shape, and/or hilum color, several other tests are conducted to help confirm variety. These tests include grow-outs such as the hypocotyl test on soybeans and coleoptile test for wheat; chemical tests such as for soybean peroxidase reactions; and fluorescence tests for oats. The certified grade applied for and kind of seed determines the amount of seed analyzed for purity (**See Chart Below**). The germination tests are conducted on 400 randomly selected seed from each sample on both certified and non-certified seed.

Certified Seed is known for its high quality, therefore a **complete analysis (purity and germ) is only conducted on cleaned seed**. Uncleaned seed may be sampled by an inspector for germ, varietal purity, noxious weeds and moisture as an aid in making conditioning decisions, but purity percentages and certified grades will not be given.

NON-CERTIFIED SEED SERVICE SAMPLES:

These are Service samples that are submitted by the seedsman/farmer that have not been applied on for certification, or do not meet the requirements for Certified Seed. The Seed Lab checks these samples for kind, weed seed, other crop, inert, and noxious weeds. **Samples that the sender designates as a particular variety will also be checked for seed characteristics, but not reported as percent other crop.** This information is recorded under Seed Characteristics on the middle part of the analysis form. **If more information is needed for labeling the percent other crop on a non-certified seed lot with variety stated, the farmer may request a Seed Characteristics Exam.** This exam is conducted on a pound of the seed and provides a good indication if other varieties or off types are present. If requested, the Lab can give the amount of obvious other varieties found above the off-types described for the variety, as a percentage under other crop.

Non-Certified seed samples may be drawn from either cleaned or uncleaned seed by the farmer/seedsman. Remember, however, the lab analysis is only as good as the sample! So try to get a sample that is representative of the lot. **(If the Plant Board is to print analysis labels, the sample must be drawn by a Plant Board Inspector from cleaned, bagged seed and variety information must be supplied.)**

REGULATORY SEED SAMPLES:

Samples that are drawn by the Plant Board from seed that has already been labeled and is in the trade channels are called regulatory samples. The Seed Lab checks these samples to determine if they are in tolerance with the analysis on the label. The location where the seed was sampled receives a regulatory analysis report stating they are in tolerance and also shows what contaminants were found (major crops only-soybeans, rice, wheat, oats). If the analysis is not in tolerance with the label, a stop-sale will be issued to prevent the seed from being sold until it has been brought into compliance with the lab's findings, or released for return to the manufacturer. The seedsman on the label is responsible for relabeling the seed or for its proper disposal. Stop sale notices are also issued by Plant Board Inspectors for technical violations such as failure to secure an Arkansas Seed Dealer's license, or insufficient information on the label. All stop-sale notices must have a written release issued by the inspector after appropriate measures are taken to correct the violation.

Records are kept for each company/individual whose name appears on the label of regulatory samples submitted to the lab. The Seed Committee of the Plant Board reviews these records each year.

The Federal Seed Act regulates seed in interstate commerce, requiring proper labeling and prohibiting misrepresentation of seed transported from one state to another. By agreement between Federal and State authorities, randomly selected regulatory seed samples of interstate shipments are sent to the USDA Federal Seed Laboratory to be grown in varietal test plots. If samples are found to be mislabeled as to variety, investigations are made to determine who is responsible for the mislabeling and appropriate actions are taken.

We do encourage all farmers, especially those that are planning to plant their own saved seed, to have it cleaned and tested to determine the quality of the seed for planting, and to help prevent the spread of weed seed, nematodes and other diseases. QUESTIONS and ANSWERS ON PLANT VARIETY PROTECTION

Q. What are the benefits of Plant Variety Protection for farmers?

A. The Plant Variety Protection Act was designed to promote the development of new varieties. Allowing Plant Breeders to determine who can sell seed of the varieties developed gives them the ability to recoup the monies expended in the process and re-invest in future variety development programs.

Researchers estimate that as much as 65% of increased performance in agricultural crops is due to improved genetics. Since 1950, the number of varieties available for Arkansas' major crops have more than tripled! Besides increases in yield, there have been improvements in disease and pest resistance, and varieties that are adapted to various soil types and production practices.

Q. What changes were made when the Plant Variety Protection Act was amended in 1994?

A. The major provisions of the 1994 PVPA:

- ◆ Prohibits the sale of any farmer saved seed without the permission of the variety owner.
- ◆ Requires that protected varieties be sold by variety name.
- ◆ Extends protection to tuber reproduced plants, varieties essentially derived from the variety, and harvested material of the variety.
- ◆ Increased length of protection to 20 years for most kinds, 25 years for trees, shrubs and vines.

Q. How can I tell if the seed I buy is protected under the 1970 or 1994 PVP?

A. The label on the bag of seed will clearly identify if the seed is protected and distinguish which Act it is protected under.

Q. Can a farmer save seed of a protected variety?

A. A farmer can save seed protected under both the 1970 and 1994 PVPA for planting on his own holdings (land owned, leased or rented).

Q. Can a farmer sell seed of a protected variety?

A. Under the 1970 PVPA - Yes, but only the amount needed to plant his own holdings.
Under the 1994 PVPA - No, unless permission is given by the variety owner.

Q. Can I clean seed for a farmer?

A. Any actions taken as a step in marketing farmer-saved seed are infringements of the rights of the owner. This can include cleaning excess seed or delivering seed to a third party. Under the 1994 PVPA, cleaning or storing farmer saved seed for sale are infringements. Anyone who cleans or conditions farmer saved seed should keep written documentation from the farmer stating that the seed being cleaned is not in violation of PVP laws or Patents.

Q. What does PVP Title V protection mean?

A. If this option is selected by the variety owner, it means the variety must be sold as a class of certified seed. Title V of the Federal Seed Act makes sales of non-certified seed of these varieties illegal.

SEED PROTECTION: RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DEFINITIONS:

1970 Plant Variety Protection Act (PVPA) - Legislation enacted to promote the development of new varieties by allowing the variety owner to determine who may sell seed of the variety. Farmers may save seed for their own planting needs and sell that amount to a neighbor, if plans for that variety change. All seed sales must comply with state seed laws. Applies to all varieties protected prior to April 4, 1995.

1994 Amended PVPA - Amendment to the Plant Variety Protection Act that prohibits the sale of any farmer saved seed without the permission of the variety owner. It also extends protection to tuber reproduced plants, varieties essentially derived from the variety, and harvested material of the variety. Seed protected under the 1994 PVPA must be sold by variety name (except for turf, forage, alfalfa & clover). Length of protection was increased to 20 years for most kinds, 25 years for trees, shrubs and vines. Applies to all varieties protected after April 4, 1995.

Title V - an option for protected varieties that allows for the sale of the seed by variety name only as a class of certified seed. Non-certified sales are prohibited. Seed may be called "Certified" only after meeting all requirements and standards of an Official Seed Certifying Agency.

Utility Patents - A means of protection for certain varieties, especially those developed through genetic engineering or biotechnology. Farmers may not save, clean/condition, or sell any seed protected under a utility patent.


